The oldest College in Southern Mizoram established in the year 1964, in its second cycle assessment and accreditation by NAAC in Feb 2017 was awarded a prestigious status B++ Grade with CGPA of 2.76. Having the motto "Summa Supremo" meaning the utmost for the highest, we pledge and strive to ensure quality education for our students with a goal to produce employable, responsible and resourceful person while attaining degrees.

The institution has been opening computer study course Triple C in collaboration with NIELIT along with regular courses. Entrepreneurship cell have been established for skill development for our student in collaboration with Planning and Programme Implementation Department, Govt of Mizoram. Career guidance, seminar/workshop and personality development classes are also frequently conducted. Both the teachers and student extends their services to local community and neighbourhood. The College was first affiliated to Gauhati University which was passed on to the North Eastern Hill University in 1973. Permanent Affiliation of the College was then passed on to Mizoram University in 2001. The College was also registered under UGC and obtained 2f and 12B. All Committees like UGC mandatory, State Govt, RUSA and internals were reconstituted in the year 2020.
