

# PRINCIPAL REPORT

LH Rothanga, Principal

I am happy to write a brief report of the College in the 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Magazine for the Academic Session 2022-2023. This writing will be my last report while in service, as I have to leave the College due to superannuation retirement on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2023. I joined LGC as Lecturer in the Department of Education on 19<sup>th</sup> March 1986 and took the responsibility of the Principal on the 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018. I have been serving in the College for more than three decades and I am happy to say that good collaborative work is the common nature among all staff. I was never left alone all the times, even during Covid-19 pandemic while all the classrooms and Hostels were utilised for Covid Care Centre/4C/QC for a long period of time. Under such circumstances, the College gradually marched forward till today.

A brief report of the College may be summarised as under:-

### 1. (a) Academic:-

Academic session 2022-2023 started on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2022. New admission was done online with using HEREUS Firm, Aizawl on merit base of Class XII results of the candidates.2022-23 student enrolment is the largest enrolment so far admitted in the College since its inception.

Professor, Department of Education and Pu Selasteen Raj, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics left the College due to Superannuation and voluntary retirement, respectively, on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022. At the same time Dr Lalhlimpuii, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, joined the College on 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 2023 on a regular basis. Meanwhile Dr Zoremsiami Pachuau, Assistant Professor, Department of History left the College as she is transferred to Government Aizawl College. I am happy to mention that six contract faculty membersb got regular appointment and joined the College on 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023. They are Lalthanmawia, Department of Political Science; Z Lalthanliana Langva, Department of Mizo; J Malsawmtluanga, Department of Mizo; H Lalremruati, Department of English; Dr H Vanlalhruaia; Department of Histor; y and K Lalthanzama, Department of Political Science.

## 3. Infrastructure development:-

- (1) Construction of Auditorium cum Annexe Building: Construction works of Auditorium cum Annexe building with a sanctioned of SPA fund of Rs 472.22 Crores started in September 2016 was completed by the end of January 2023 and the building was handed over to the Principal, LGC by PWD Building Project Division, Lunglei on 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb 2023.
- (2) RUSA-02 upgradation works: RUSA upgradation works and purchase were partly done like Step upgradation, Gazebo, Student sitting facility, Library front PCC works and Boys Hostel vertical extension and we are still waiting for the completion of other works.

- 4. National Cadet Corps: National Cadet Corps now well established under 20,Mizoram NCC. The Cadets participated in the Independent day parade of 2022 and awarded 1<sup>st</sup> prize among unarmed contingent. This is the first time the College NCC joined parade in the National day celebration. In 2023 Republic Day celebration our NCC was awarded 2<sup>nd</sup> prize among unarmed contingent. This is really one of the outstanding achievements of the College. Two caretakers from our faculty members "Dr T Malsawmtluanga, Dept. of Physics and Miss C Lalnunpuii, Dept. of English were assigned the responsibility of NCC.
- Programme Officers, viz: R Lalrochama (NSS State Award holder), Dr R Vanlalvena, H Lalremruati, Benjamin L Chhangte and J. Malsawmtluanga. Volunteers of NSS performed activities both inside and outside College by participating in health and sanitation programmes, social works, planting of trees, blood donation and certain awareness programmes related to HIV, etc.

The College NSS Unit conducted Blood donation camp on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 at RUSA Hall where a total of 94 units have been donated (57 male and 37 Female) from faculty members and students. The Blood Bank of Lunglei Civil Hospital conducted the camp.

- 6. **Fresher Social:** Fresher social for welcoming new student was organised on 12.8.22 at Saikuti Hall. All 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester students were detailed to attend the programme. Due to limitation of seat at Saikuti Hall, all 3<sup>rd</sup> semester students could not be included in the programme.
- 7. **College week:** Due to Covid 19 pandemic, the College couldnot organise 'offline College week' for two consecutive years. The College week was held during 12<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2022 at convenient places and students actively and happily performed different items under the supervision of SU and faculty incharges. The week concluded successfully.
- **8. MSSSB Exam:** The College host for the conduct of AAO and Asst Grade examination under Mizoram subordinate Selection Board during 14 and 15, Sept 22 and 8<sup>th</sup> Nov 22, under the supervision of the Principal. Faculty are appointed as invigilators and exam was conducted smoothly and successfully.

### 9. Vaccination:-

Precautionary dose of Covid 19 vaccination for faculty members and students was held at College premises on 21.9.22. Team from the Chief Medical Officers' office conducted the programme.

10. P& E Seminar: Seminar on Energy conservation was held on 22.2.22 at Rusa hall. This was organised by Electrical Inspectorate, P&E Department, Govt of Mizoram, in which one LED bulb was presented to all participants.

In pursuance of this seminar, Implementation of Energy Efficiency Activity in Govt Institute programme was held at Lunglei Govt College on 12<sup>th</sup> April 23 in which no of Electrical goods were presented to the College by Chief Electrical Inspectorate Office, Aizawl.

- 11. National Education Policy 2020: Committee on implementation NEP 2020 have been constituted and Seminar programme for faculty was organised on 2.9.22, in which Dr DK Jha, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry was the resource person. Another seminar was also held on 25.11.22.
- 12. HIV Awareness: HIV-AIDS awareness programme was held on 26.9.22 in collaboration with MSACS (MHIP) and NSS, LGC, in which migrant students are detailed to attend the programme. A total of 139 students have their blood tested and fortunately no one was found positive.
- **13. IBM Skillbuild:** IBM skillbuild orientation session was organised by CSRBOX and EK Cell of LGC on 14.11.2022, in which MR Ajinkia Madkaiker, MNRGE fellow delivered speech.
- **14. College Week Closing:** Week closing function was held on 9<sup>th</sup> Dec 2022 at Saikuti Hall. Prizes and Certificate were distributed during the function.
- 15. Football match: In celebration of construction of artificial turf for the second time at Thuamluaia Mual, football match was played between LGC and Government J. Buana College on 10.12.22 in presence of Honble Ministers "C Lalrinsanga, Robert Romawia Royte and other officials. LGC team won by 2-0.

- Magazine release: 2021-2022 Annual Magazine was released by Principal 16. Mr LH Rothanga at RUSA Hall on 3.2.23. Selected students attended the function.
- Leadership Development training: Leadership development on SDG 17. Emersion online training was conducted by Planning and Programme Implementation Department, GOM with the help of EK Cell (Entrepreneur Knowledge Cell) Committee members. Only selected students were detailed to attend the programme.

Skill training of Rural Youth on Mushroom productivity was organised on 6.2.23 by ATMA Lunglei in collaboration with EK Cell. Principal Mr LH Rothanga was the Chief Guest of the programme . Botany and Geology students attended the function.

- RBI Campaign: Reserve Bank Of India conducted Financial Literacy 18. campaign for faculty on 16.2.23 . Career Guidance on RBI was also conducted on the same day for all final year female students.
- 19. Cyber Security awareness: Cyber security and emerging technology awareness for College students was held at RUSA hall on 2.3.23. Mr Rahul Alwal IPS, Superintendent of Police, Lunglei was the Chief Guest and Mr TN Singh, Director, NIELIT and Mr LH Rothanga Principal, LGC were Guest of Honours in the programme. This was jointly organised by the college's IQAC, SU and NIELIT, Aizawl.
- National Seminar: National Seminar on Intellectual Property Rights 20. (IPR) was held on 15.7.22. It was jointly organised by Mizoram Science, Technology and Innovation Council (MISTIC) and IPR Cell of LGC and Dr Lalruatfela Renthlei, Dept of Physics presented a paper.

Moreover, National Science Day was observed under the initiative taken by Dr T Malsawmtluanga, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics on 28th Feb,23 in collaboration with MISTIC. All Science students were present in the programme. Dr. B. Ramngaihawma (Asst. Professor, Dept. of Geology) and Dr. Lalruatfela Renthlei (Asst. Prof, Dept. of Physics) presented papers.

Institutional workshop on Preparation of AQAR and SSR, challenge and opportunities was held on 2.3.23 for all faculty members, in which Dr H Vanlalhruaia, Dept. of History was the resource person.

- 21. Faculty teaching exchange programme: The following departments of LGC conducted teaching exchange programme: Philosophy department with Higher & Technical Institute of Mizoram, Lunglei; Political Science Department with Govt J Buana College and Botany Department with Govt Serchhip College.
- **MZU Sport:** MZU sports was held from 20<sup>th</sup> March to 24<sup>th</sup> March,23 at Aizawl.82 students from LGC went as delegate for various items. LGC team won Bronze medal in Badminton (Men) and Silver Medal in 100 metre race.
- 23. Sensitization on Anemia prevention and promotion of Millet based food nutrition was organized by Women and Child Development, Social Welfare Department, Lunglei District in collaboration with Women Grievances Redressal Cell, LGC on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 23, in which female students from English and Education were present.
- 24. Cultural Club Activity: Cultural Club of LGC performed various Cultural dances on 31.3.23 at Basket ball Court. Faculty and students witness the programme. The College Cultural Club performed cultural dances at South Vanlaiphai during MZP general conference, in which the Club won the best performance certificate. The College Cultural Club also made music video under ZONET JB Rimawi Huang.
- 25. SDG Symposium: Sustainable Development Goals (Local Emersion programme for higher Education) was organized by Planning and Programme Implementation Department, Govt of Mizoram at Vanapa Hall, Aizawl in which 6 selected students from LGC participated in the programme.
- **26. Lunglei Municipal Council Election:** 1<sup>st</sup> LMC election was held on 29<sup>th</sup> March,23. A total of 16 staff members of Lunglei Govt College were deputed for various assignments and they performed their task successfully.
