OF
UNDERSTANDING** 

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and executed on this day, **27th March 2023**

Between

Department of Philosophy, Lunglei Government College (LGC), Lunglei
(Hereinafter referred to as "LGC", which expression shall include
its successors and permitted assignees) on FIRST PART

And



Department of Philosophy, Higher and Technical Institute Mizoram (HATIM), Lunglei
(Hereafter referred to as "HATIM", which expression shall include
its successor and permitted assignees) on SECOND PART.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between LGC and HATIM is entered into for the purpose of a **Student Exchange Programme** between the two parties, the objective of which is to promote and enhance student exposure, student learning, practicality and sharing of knowledge in the field of Philosophy.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premise and actual covenants herein contained, both LGC and HATIM, agree to the following undermentioned terms and arrangements:

A. Terms of the MoU:

- The two parties agree to enter into a Student Exchange Programme agreement during and or within the academic year 2022-2023.
- The participating students will constitute the VI Semester of respective colleges.

- (iii) Each institution may send at least one or two faculty to participate in the exchange programme. The number of the faculty may either be increased or decreased subject to mutual agreement of both institutions.
- (iv) Each institution will appoint an individual to act as the coordinator for the exchange. The exchange is co-ordinated in LGC through the Coordinator, Faculty Exchange Programme and in HATIM through the Coordinator, Faculty Exchange Programme.
- (v) The host institutions will have the right to refusal of any candidate who may appear to be unacceptable for the exchange. Each sending institution will follow the exchange application deadline set by the receiving institution.

B. Financial Arrangements:

- (i) Bearing in mind the proximity of both institutions, no TA/DA will be paid to the respective participants by either institution.
- (ii) However, the VI Semester of LGC will be given a sum of rupees 500/- as a group to cover travel expenses.

C. Resources and Regulations at the Host Institution:

- (i) Students participating in the program will be free to choose courses or topic (s) of his/her choice provided that it is within the purview of the subject matter of "Philosophy" in purview of the syllabus from the affiliated university, Mizoram University
- (ii) At the end of the exchange programme, the host institution shall send an official report and/or transcript of their academic achievement to the home institution.
- (iii) Students participating in the programme are subject to the rules and regulations of the host institutions. The host institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating students at any time for academic or personal misconduct. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the agreement for the arrangements regarding other participants.

D. Duration, Amendment and Termination of Agreement:

The parties involved will review the terms of the MoU as and when deemed necessary to assess the success of the exchange and will determine whether to continue, modify or terminate the same.




or discontinue the MoU. Each Party reserves the right to terminate this MoU upon one month's written notice to the other.

- (ii) The proposed duration of the student exchange programme is set to take place within two consecutive days, i.e., 30th and 31st March, 2023.
- (iii) The MoU shall take effect when signed by both parties, and will remain in effect until the end of the 2022-2023 academic session.


D. Conduct of Student Exchange Programme:


- (i) The Student Exchange Programme may be conducted at Higher and Technical Institute Mizoram through offline mode where students are expected to be physically present throughout the programme.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (NIELIT) LUNGLEI AND LUNGLEI GOVERNMENT COLLEGE, LUNGLEI, ON OPENING NIELIT STUDY CENTRE

This AGREEMENT is made and entered into this day 12th March 2021.

The National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) Extension Centre Lunglei represented for and on his behalf by Mr. F LALRINAWMA, Scientist 'D, National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) Extension Centre Lunglei (herein after referred to as 'NIELIT' which express shall unless repugnant to the content or meaning thereof include its successors and permitted assigned) on the ONE PART

and

The Lunglei Government College Lunglei, represented for and on his behalf by its Principal, Mr. LH ROTHANGA (herein after referred to as "LGC" which express shall unless repugnant to the content or meaning thereof include its successors and permitted assigned) on the OTHER PART

Whereas, the NIELIT is entrusted to allot twenty (20) Computers Sets and Multimedia Projector at the NIELIT STUDY CENTRE Laboratory for the students who enroll/ register for NIELIT Courses to acquire Computer knowledge for Computer Literacy and employment, as NIELIT STUDY CENTRE is meant for the development of youths in Computer Education.

Whereas, the LGC shall provide adequate room to be used for NIELIT STUDY CENTRE for free of cost, and will also provide Electricity free of cost.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESS AND it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto.

1. ADMISSION PROCEDURES:

- LGC shall give admission in the applicable NIELIT Courses amongst its bona fide students by giving information and publishing in Notice Board, in consultation with the Faculty of NIELIT, and such students will be allotted Class/Lab timing in Batch-wise for the particular NIELIT Course they choose, within the applicable working hour of the College.
- NIELIT may also give admission in the applicable NIELIT Courses amongst the youth within the Town area of Lunglei who are not students of LGC by giving information through e-media, print media and also publishing in Notice Board, in consultation with the LGC, and such students will be allotted Class/Lab timing in Batch-wise for the particular NIELIT Course they choose, within the applicable working hour of NIELIT which is **9:00 a.m to 5:30 p.m.**
- The main object of the Course is NIELIT CCC Course with a minimum contact hour of 80 hours.
- Registration for the course (CCC) must be completed before or by 15th of every month for every new batches of every month, if there are any.

- e. Apart from NIELIT CCC, admission to available other NIELIT Courses under NSQF (National Skills Qualifications Framework) will be notified from time to time.
- f. The Course fees/ Registration Fees/ Examination Fees if applicable, must be paid at the time of admission/registration and the amount will be notified from time to time, as and whenever possible.
- g. All other NIELIT students admitted/ enrolled at NIELIT STUDY CENTRE - LUNGLEI GOVT COLLEGE, who are not bona fide students of LGC must obey the rules and regulations laid down for the students of LUNGLEI GOVT COLLEGE.

2. ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGC:

- a. LGC will provide a classroom spacious enough to accommodate 20 (twenty) Computer Systems per batch of 20 Students.
- b. LGC will provide Electricity free of cost.
- c. LGC will try to incorporate the NIELIT Computer Courses in their daily routine so as to fit within the time frame of the college class hours / working hours.
- d. LGC will provide security measures for the Computer Systems and other items belonging to NIELIT STUDY CENTRE - LUNGLEI GOVT COLLEGE within its own capacity.

3. ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES OF NIELIT LUNGLEI:

- a. NIELIT will provide Faculty/ Computer Instructor.
- b. NIELIT will provide study material for the course.
- c. NIELIT will conduct examinations at the NIELIT LUNGLEI CENTRE, IIDC COMPLEX, PUKPUI, as and when applicable within the NIELIT Examination Cycles.
- d. NIELIT will provide Maintenance of Computer Systems and Electrical wiring system.
- e. NIELIT will try to provide more Computer Systems as and when needed, depending upon the demand of the students and the participation of the LGC Authorities.

This agreement will be subjected to revision after two years and may result in renewal or withdrawal of the agreement all together, depending upon the response, demand and participation of students and LGC Authorities.
